





The "Willkomm" is one of the earliest "key experiences" of the MEISSEN manufactory. Made by Johann Jakob Irminger, one of the pioneers of porcelain design, August the Strong is said to have drunk from the legendary porcelain key during a visit to Albrechtsburg Meissen - according to the entry in the guest book from 1714. Until 1864, Albrechtsburg Castle was the place where the "White Gold" was made and the secret recipes of the Meissen alchemists were kept. The "Willkomm" was the king's MEISSEN scepter! Like a magic key, it allowed its owner symbolic entry into the world of Meissen's art. Originally 40 cm long, the "Willkomm" was pompously and distinctly imaginatively staged at courtly festivities in the Baroque and Rococo periods. A popular little ceremony since the 17th century was part of it: to hand the guests a "Willkomm" for a drink. Since the middle of the 18th century, the MEISSEN manufactory has been producing them from the highly coveted precious "white gold".
